Re: The Preservation of Present Beach Accesses and Rights of Waterways in the South Sound area and in the entire District of George Town

Enclosed please find a number of affidavits in respect of the present beach accesses in South Sound.

Subject to the provision of the Registered Land Law and the Prescription Law in respect to easements we wish for action to commence immediately for these accesses to be acquired and to continue to be used by the public of the Cayman Islands.

At the same time when dealing with the above, we request that all existing rights of waterways presently used by the public should be secured as well. Some of these waterways would include:

1. George Town Barcadere
2. Any other existing waterways in the district of George Town

On behalf of the Caymanian public we wish to claim and preserve these accesses by having them gazetted and indicated on the Registry Index Map.
